NATIONWIDE WAIVER-EXTENSION 7

Como todos saben, las Escuelas Públicas de Española están participando en el Programa de Servicio de Alimentos de Verano (SFSP) en julio de 2022. Se nos informó que se ha extendido una Exención Nacional para Permitir la Alimentación No Congregada para las Operaciones de Verano. Lo que esto significa es que a partir del lunes 18 de julio, un niño de 1 a 18 años puede tomar una comida fuera del sitio. Hay algunas reglas que se deben seguir y que se enumeran a continuación:

1. Las comidas solo se sirven a niños de 1 a 18 años y en los horarios de servicio.
2. Los niños de 1 a 18 años deben estar presentes para recibir una comida. Una vez que se recibe la comida, pueden salir del sitio o comer en el sitio supervisado.
3. El desayuno y el almuerzo no se pueden servir al mismo tiempo, lo que significa que solo se dará una comida a la vez. Ejemplo: si el niño está allí para el desayuno, solo se dará el desayuno, pero ese mismo niño puede regresar para el almuerzo.
4. Los niños no pueden recibir comidas para hermanos en casa, los hermanos deben estar presentes. Un padre NO puede recoger la comida de un hermano en casa.
5. No se servirán comidas múltiples para varios días.
6. No hay rutas de autobús. Todas las comidas deben recogerse en una ubicación aprobada por SFSP
7. No hay puntos de entrega de comida a granel.
8. No hay entrega de comidas puerta a puerta.
